SUMMER COBBLER COCKTAIL

SERVING: 1 DRINK TIME: 5 MINUTES

INGREDIENTS

-3 tablespoons (1 1/2 oz.) white whiskey -1 1/2 tablespoons (3/4 oz.) Grand Marnier or other orange-flavored liqueur1 -1 tablespoon fresh lime juice -1 1/2 teaspoons Blackberry Preserves -3 fresh blackberries -fresh blackberries and lime peel twist for garnish

DIRECTIONS

Combine 3 Tbsp. (1 1/2 oz.) white whiskey, 1 1/2 Tbsp. (3/4 oz.) Grand Marnier or other orange-flavored liqueur, 1 Tbsp. fresh lime juice, 1 1/2 tsp. Blackberry Farm Blackberry Preserves, and 3 fresh blackberries in an ice-filled cocktail shaker. Cover with lid, and shake until mixed and thoroughly chilled, about 45 seconds. Strain whiskey mixture into an oldfashioned glass filled with crushed ice. Garnish with fresh blackberries and lime peel twists.



CHAMPAGNE COCKTAIL

SERVING: 1 DRINK TIME: 5 MINUTES


INGREDIENTS

-1 sugar cube -Angostura bitters -Sparkling wine -Lemon twist for garnish

DIRECTIONS

Put sugar cube in a Champagne glass. Lightly sprinkle the sugar cube with Angostura bitters and pour in enough sparkling wine to fill the glass. Garnish with a lemon twist before serving.







TOM COLLINS

SERVING: 1 DRINK TIME: 5 MINUTES

INGREDIENTS

-2 ounces gin -1 ounce fresh lemon juice -1/2 ounce simple syrup club soda -Lemon maraschino cherry to garnish

DIRECTIONS

Add the gin, lemon juice and simple syrup into a Collins glass.Fill with ice, top with club soda and stir.Garnish with a lemon wheel and maraschino cherry (optional).
























QUESTIONS WITH LAUREN

"DO I REALLY NEED VERBAL CONSENT?"

WHAT IS VERBAL Consent?

I think we can all agree that consent is a no-brainer, but what is consent? And what is good enough? Strictly physical cues, like being kissed back, aren't enough. Consent is 50/50. Both people must agree to sex, *every single time*, for it to be consensual. On Planned Parenthood's website, they say "Consent is as easy as FRIES". It reads as follows:

- Freely given. Consenting is a choice you make without pressure, manipulation, or under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- **Reversible**. Anyone can change their mind about what they feel like doing, *anytime*. Even if you've done it before, and even if you're both naked in bed.
- **Informed**. You can only consent to something if you have the full story. For example, if someone says they'll use a condom and then they don't, there isn't full consent.

- **Specific**. Saying yes to one thing (like going to the bedroom to make out) doesn't mean you've said yes to anthing else (like having sex).

Consent is *always* clearly communicated — there should be no if, ands, or buts about it. Silence is not consent. Smiling is not consent. Kissing is not consent. *Verbal consent is consent*. And it's not just important on first dates or hook-ups! Even couples who've had sex before, or even have sex often, still need to consent to having sex. Every. Single. Time.

Sex is best when both parties are comfortable, enthusiastic, and consenting adults. *Trust me.*
